School Meals

The children seem to be loving their deli-bar lunch provided by Absolutely Catering so I am going to continue to fund a free school meal for every pupil to the end of the year. We will also continue to provide free toast every morning.

Appropriate Clothing

Just a reminder that pupils are not required to wear school uniform but that football kits are not allowed.

Daily Attendance

As explained in our Bubble FAQs, all children in the bubbles must attend every day, all day. If your child is ill and unable to come to school can you please phone the School Office to notify us. This will save us having to call you to check the reason for their absence. Please give a clear reason for their absence and remember that **if your child has any Covid-19 symptoms we need to be informed as soon as possible.**

Zoom Sessions

All pupils in our bubbles participate in the Zoom session for their own year-groups along with their friends at home. We do still need you to return the Google Form to give your permission for them to take part (link sent out via Marvellous Me).

Transition Meetings

Every pupil and one parent/carer are being invited to attend a group transition meeting in school with their current teacher and their new teacher. This invitation applies to all pupils in bubbles, not just those at home. A letter will be sent out shortly with further details.

Last Day in School

The last day in school for all 'bubble' children will be **Friday 17th July**. We are already planning some special celebrations on that day for both children and staff.
