As ever, we want your child to achieve the very best that they can. We have extremely high expectations of attendance, punctuality, behaviour and conduct and expect that you will support us to enable your child to thrive.

## Reading

It is vital that your child is reading at home for at least 20 minutes 5 times per week (10 minutes for Year 2). This needs to be signed in their reading diary. At the moment, due to current restrictions, school reading books can only be changed on a Thursday. Please ensure that, finished or not, your child brings their reading book and diary in on a Thursday.

## Homework

We would like you to continue using all online apps at home (TT Rockstars, Spelling Shed etc.). Your children were given login details for these apps; however, if you need them re-sending so that you can continue to support your children at home, please let us know.

All Y3&4 children will be given spellings on a Friday which they must learn for a test the following Friday. In addition, we would ask that the children access 'TT Rockstars' and 'Spelling



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Shed' at least three times a week (TT Rockstars daily for Y4). Other homework will be sent out throughout the year as we feel appropriate.

## PE

PE kits are to be kept at home and worn to school on the days when the children have PE. As the winter draws in, the children may wear black/ navy joggers and a jumper over their PE kit.
