

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development (Prime)

- Taking responsibility for their belongings
- Adapting to changes in routine
- Adhering to school rules (BV)
- Dealing with conflict (BV)
- Understanding how actions affect other people, showing empathy for others
- Support and encourage peers when undertaking a task
- Following school rules (BV)
- HL: Discuss how your child can help someone to feel better if they are sad and why it's important

### Mathematical Development (Specific)

- Counting up to and including 20 and back
- Beginning to count beyond 20
- Counting in 2's to 10
- Recognise & order numerals 1-5, 1-10
- Counting out a set number of objects
- Uses the language more/fewer to compare a set of objects
- Finding 1 more/1 less for a group of objects
- Practical addition and subtraction activities
- HL: Children to practice counting out a set number of objects and writing the numeral

### Expressive Arts and Design (Specific)

- Christmas/birthday cards
- Diva lamps & Rangoli patterns for Diwali
- Making firework pictures
- Participating in a variety of singing activities
- Playing together to develop and act out a storyline/narrative they have introduced into their play (BV)
- Exploring different textures and tools and techniques they can use to manipulate them.
- HL: Share children's knowledge and understanding of different celebrations (BV)

### Physical Development (Prime)

- Parachute/scarves/ring games
- Developing balancing skills through yoga poses
- Managing snack
- Develops increasing control over an object
- Letter formation/presentation
- Handling a variety of tools and equipment safely e.g. new outdoor equipment and scissors
- HL: Continue to give children lots of writing tools to access at home.

### Understanding the World (Specific)

- Sharing experiences of family customs and routines
- Celebrations including Diwali/Hanukkah/Christmas
- Investigating signs of winter in the outdoor environment
- Ice balloons experiment freezing and melting
- HL: Share experiences of celebrations with your child when you were their age

### Communication & Language (Prime) Literacy (Specific)

- Maintaining appropriate attention throughout a number of various activities
- Sequencing stories & events
- Continuing to develop listening skills in a variety of situations (BV)
- Continues a rhyming string
- Represents some/all sounds correctly
- Recognising and writing their own name and other familiar words
- Beginning to write for a purpose
- Can segment and blend simple words for reading and writing
- Continuing to develop letter formation including entry and exit flicks
- HL: Writing for a purpose: Letters, cards, lists etc.
