



## Parent Voice – Year 6 Leavers 2016/17

### Context:

All the parents/carers of children leaving Year 6 at the end of the 2016/17 academic year were given the opportunity to respond to our exit questionnaire in July 2017. Parents/carers read 18 statements about key areas of the school deciding whether they strongly agree, agree, disagree or strongly disagree with them.

- 30 questionnaires were completed.
- There were 44 children in the cohort.
- The views of the majority of the cohort's parents/carers (68%) were represented.
- This was a very good rate of return, producing a sample that would be representative of the cohort.

***Nearly all parents/carers (97%) agree with the statement 'I would recommend this school to a friend', with the vast majority of parents (72%) strongly agreeing with the statement.***

### **Safety:**

- ✓ Nearly all parents/carers (97%) agree that their child was safe at our school, with the vast majority of parents (80%) strongly agreeing with the statement.

### **Dealing with Issues:**

- ✓ The vast majority of parents (90%) agree that our school deals effectively with any issues that may escalate into bullying, including cyber, racist and homophobic incidents.
- ✓ The vast majority of parents (87%) agree that our school responds well to concerns raised by them, with 90% communicating that these concerns were managed well.

### **Teaching:**

- ✓ The overwhelming majority of parents (97%) agree that their children is taught well at our school, with the vast majority (77%) strongly agreeing with the statement.

### **Progress:**

- ✓ All of the parents/carers agree that their child has had good progress this year, with the vast majority of (80%) strongly agreeing with the statement.
- ✓ All of the parents/carers agree that their child has had good progress during their time at our school, with the vast majority of (83%) strongly agreeing with the statement.



#### **Meeting Individual Needs:**

- ✓ Nearly all parents/carers (97%) agree that our school meets their child's individual needs, with the vast majority (73%) strongly agreeing with the statement.

#### **Enjoyment, experiences and opportunities:**

- ✓ All parents agree that their children have fun and memorable experiences at our school.
- ✓ The vast majority of parents (93%) agree that our school offers a good range of after school clubs.
- ✓ All parents agree that their child was offered a good range of sporting opportunities.
- ✓ The overwhelming majority of parents (97%) agree that their child was offered a good range of artistic, including music and singing, opportunities.
- ✓ The overwhelming majority of parents (97%) agree that their child had good opportunities to participate in residential visits – with the one parent (3%) acknowledging that school has addressed this situation for future cohorts.

#### **Homework, Supporting Learning and Transition:**

- ✓ The vast majority of parents (90%) agree that our school provides adequate homework, with the majority (60%) strongly agreeing with the statement.
- ✓ The vast majority of parents (93%) felt well supported by school when helping children with their learning, with the vast majority (60%) strongly agreeing with the statement.
- ✓ The vast majority of parents (93%) felt well supported by school when helping children with their learning, with the vast majority (60%) strongly agreeing with the statement.
- ✓ The overwhelming majority of parents (97%) felt well supported when choosing their child's secondary school.

#### **Communication:**

- ✓ The vast majority of parents (93%) felt well supported by school when helping children with their learning, with the vast majority (63%) strongly agreeing with the statement.
